**One author** - Black (2008:20) argues that.....**OR**  
macroeconomics is defined as the..... (Black, 2008:20).

**More than one author**- Black, Smit & Mohr (2008:27)  
argues that.....**OR** macroeconomics is defined as the.....  
(Black, Smit & Mohr, 2008)

**Note:** all authors are listed at first and et.al is used only when you repeat the references
